Alaskan Dream	Yes	Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination required for all sailings beginning in May 2021.
American Queen	Yes	If a guest is not able to receive both doses of the COVID-19 vaccine prior to their scheduled trip, the cruise line will rebook the guest for a future sailing at no charge.
Avalon Cruises	Yes	<p><a href="#">Travelers are now required to offer Globus family of brands' personnel one of the following printed and/or digital verifications upon arrival: Proof of COVID-19 vaccination at least 14 days prior to travel, Proof of a negative COVID-19 test, or proof of recovery.</a></p> <p><a href="#">Guests unable to provide this may move their plans to any other 2021 or 2022 destination or itinerary.</a></p>
Carnival	No	<a href="#">As of May 10, Carnival has not made a decision about requiring guests to provide proof of vaccines.</a>
Celebrity Cruises	Yes	<a href="#">All passengers over the age of 16 on the company's Alaska and Galapagos voyages.</a>
Crystal Cruises	Yes	<a href="#">No exceptions: option to move or cancel until 60 days prior to first service without penalty</a>
Cunard	Yes	<a href="#">Proof of vaccination required for boarding on Queen Elizabeth summer 2021 sailings.</a>
Disney Cruises	Yes	<a href="#">As of April 24, Guests 18 years of age and older must be fully vaccinated (7 days after 2nd dose). Guests who aren't fully vaccinated will be rebooked.</a>
Grand Circle	Yes	<a href="#">All travelers joining us aboard our small ships must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 at least 14 days prior to departure by one of the three vaccines currently being distributed throughout the U.S. from Moderna, Pfizer, or Johnson &amp; Johnson. Traveler</a>
Holland America Line	Yes	<a href="#">Cruises for guests who have received final dose of an approved COVID-19 vaccine at least 14 days prior to cruise date and have proof of vaccination</a>
Hornblower Groups	Yes	Guest will be denied boarding and rebooked on a future cruise at no charge.

Lindblad Expeditions	Yes	<a href="#">All passengers over the age of 16 on the company's Alaska and Galapagos voyages.</a>
MSC Cruises	No	<a href="#">As of May 10, proof of vaccine is not required, however, all guests must take a RT-PCR test prior to departure. Guests not considered fit to travel will be assisted in their next steps of a return home or be treated in local medical facility.</a>
Norwegian Cruise Lines	Yes	<a href="#">Vaccinations will be part of NCL's SailSafe Health &amp; Safety Program. Includes the Oceana Cruise brand</a>

Seabourn	Yes	<a href="#">Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination at least 14 days prior to embarkation on all Seabourn Ovation sailings from Athens.</a>
Silver Seas	Yes	Guest will be denied boarding and issued a Future Cruise Credit
UnCruise Adventures	Yes	<a href="#">Passengers over 18 and crew. Passengers under 18 will require a negative PCR test.</a>

Victory Cruise Lines	Yes	Guest will be denied boarding and rebooked on a future cruise at no charge.
Viking Cruises	Yes	<a href="#"><u>Depending on dates of travel, Viking may require verification of COVID-19 vaccination status as part of the digital Health Survey.</u></a>
Virgin Voyages	Yes	<a href="#"><u>Both passengers and crew must be vaccinated before allowed boarding</u></a>
Windstar Cruises	Yes	<a href="#"><u>Windstar announced on March 30 that all guests are required proof of current COVID-19 vaccines.</u></a>
